

WHERE TO USE

Mapefloor Cleaner ED is suitable in all those cases where a strong detergent is required on surfaces which are not subject to damage by water.

Mapefloor Cleaner ED has been specially developped for cleaning resin floors, such as the **Mapefloor System**, and leaves a clean, shiny finish on the floor surface.

Some application examples

- Cleaning treatment for resin floors made using the Mapefloor System internal environment for civil, public and industrial use.
- Cleaning treatment for protective films on decorative floors made using **Ultratop**, including those mixed with natural aggregates and in environments for civil use such as showrooms, shops and apartments.

TECHNICAL CHARACTERISTICS

Mapefloor Cleaner ED is a concentrated water-soluble product made of a special mixture of surfactant, low-foaming components, for cleaning greasy stains from washable surfaces and floors subject to heavy traffic. The action of the surfactant components is completed by the solvent and deodorising action of the terpinolene contained in the product. The product contains a minimum of 90% of biodegradable surfactant components.

How to use

The product may be used by hand or with mechanical cleaning means.

Use **Mapefloor Cleaner ED** at a concentration from 1 to 3% (100-300 g in 10 litres of water).

Increase the concentration according to requirements on porous or heavily soiled surfaces.

PACKAGING

Mapefloor Cleaner ED is available in 10 kg cans.

Ingredients according to Regulation (EC) No 648/2004 Less than 5% soap, non ionic surfactants, EDTA and salts, phosphates, parfumes (D-Limonene),preservation agents (mixing of 5-chlore-2-methyl-2H-isotiazol-3-one and methyl-2H-isotiazol-3-one (3:1).

STORAGE

Mapefloor Cleaner ED can be stored for 24 months in its original packaging at a temperature between +10°C and +30°C. Protect from frost.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR PREPARATION AND APPLICATION

Mapefloor Cleaner ED is irritant for the eyes.

When applying the product, we recommend using protective gloves and goggles and to take the usual precautions for handling chemical products. If the product comes into contact with the eyes or skin, wash immediately with plenty of clean water and seek medical attention.
